United Way of the Dutchess-Orange Region's Day of Sharing boutique and Louis Greenspan Children's Corner are full of goods for area nonprofits, schools and faith-based organizations to "shop" for necessities for their clients - for free.

The over \$200,000 renovation of the Day of Sharing space as well as the exterior of United Way's main office, the Evelyn Samuels Memorial Building (Hasbrouck House), listed on the National Register of Historic Places, was completed in September 2019 thanks to support of Senator Sue Serino with a \$100,000 grant to United Way from the Dormitory Authority of the State of New York (DASNY) as well as the RL Baxter Building Corp and other donors.

United Way began its nationally recognized Day of Sharing program when the Dutchess and Orange County United Way's merged in 2011. Each year, the number of people served and the amount of goods distributed has grown exponetially. Last year, more than \$200,000 in necessities were distributed to 7446 families. This year we hope to help 10,000 families with \$300,000 in necessities. We're expanding our Day of Sharing to two sessions and will open our doors from 10am to noon and 2pm to 4pm. We want to ensure that our neighbors will have bedding, household and kitchen items, men's and women's clothes as well as items for infants and children at no cost. This Day was created to help support our fight for the health, education and financial stability of every person in our community.

We extend our invitation to Day of Sharing to all nonprofit agencies, faith-based organizations and schools serving residents of Dutchess and Orange counties without charge. No prior resservations are necessary, but we do request each group receiving in-kind donations complete and return the Gift-In-Kind Policies and Procedures document (available online at www.uwdor.org/dayofsharing).


